

The 2015 Nepal earthquake

The 2015 Nepal Earthquake occurred on 25th of April at 11.56 am killed at least 6300 people and injured more than 10000 people. It was the most powerful disaster to strike Nepal since the year 1934 and the intensity and magnitude was 7.8 Richter scale. Some casualties have also been reported in the adjoining areas of India, China and Bangladesh. India responded with Maitri promptly for rescue and relief in Nepal by its armed forces and also evacuated Indian and foreign citizens from Nepal.

The earthquake triggered an avalanche on Mount Everest killing at least 19 making it the deadliest day on the mountain in the history of Nepal. It triggered another huge avalanche in Langtang valley where 250 are now missing, centuries – old buildings, temples, monuments are destroyed.

Geophysicists and other experts had warned for decades that Nepal was vulnerable to a deadly earthquake, particularly because of its geology, urbanization and architecture.

Every global citizen, individuals, institutions, Govt. and non – governmental organizations locally and internationally must come forward and extend unceasing support and cooperation day in and day out so as to bring alive ones into a normal life fulfilling with their basic amenities and facilities.
